If only one participant or one team is registered in a discipline, the discipline is canceled without replacement if it cannot be combined with another discipline.

Competition rules and tournament regulations:

In principle, the rules and regulations of the DKV apply with the following exceptions.

The judges reserve the right to make further changes on the day of the competition if necessary.

Kata

Generally point system

Up to 6 participants in one discipline: direct final round

7-12 participants in a discipline: 2 groups of 3 to 6 participants = 3 participants each to the final

13-24 participants in a discipline: 2 groups of 6-12 participants each = 6 further = 2 groups of 6 participants each,

Groups are mixed = 3 participants each into the final

From 25 participants in a discipline: = 4 groups of at least 6 participants = 3 participants each further = 2 groups of 6 participants each, Groups are mixed = 3 participants each into the final

The final will be held with 6 participants in a group using the point system. Placements in Kata place 1 – 4

Children:

The kata is free in each round and may be repeated (a kata required)

Juniors:

The kata is free in each round. A kata that has already been shown may be repeated, but not in the each subsequent round (two kata required)

Youth, juniors, seniors, master class:

The choice of kata is free. No kata may be repeated.

Kumite singles

Up to 8 participants in a discipline: table system 9 to 16 participants in a discipline: double KO system

From 17 participants in a discipline: Bras KO system with Trr.

Competition time and scoring system:

All fights in point system

Children, students, students/youth team = 1.5 min.eff.

Youth, juniors, seniors, master class, juniors/seniors team = 2.0 min eff.

Kumite team

3 fighters + max. 2 substitutes, otherwise like single kumite.

A team must start with at least 2 fighters.

Reinforcements from other age groups are not permitted.

Juniors /Youth:

The starting order depends on the height of the athletes $\!\!\!/$ smallest starter first, tallest last.

Protectors: The following protectors are mandatory.

Fist, foot and shin protection (red/blue), groin protection for men, chest protection for women,

Mouthguard, body protector is allowed. Other bandages are prohibited unless they have been applied by the competition doctor on the day of the competition.

Deviations children:

Chest protection is mandatory for children if the anatomical requirements are met. The responsible decision as to the requirement rests with the parents.

Fist and foot protection (red/blue) mandatory.

Braces are only allowed provided the contestant accepts full responsibility for any injury. Minors require written parental consent. At the start, the existence of this declaration of consent is required.

Coach: Each coach is obliged to inform themselves in advance about the rules and regulations of the DKV. Supervisors are only allowed in training clothes (track pants, t-shirt, sports shoes) or karate-gi.
